Loss of Water: Have bottled water available for drinking purposes. Call the water department. Ca	all the
parents if the water will remain out of service for an extended length of time.	
Serious Injury to a Child: Call 911 or the police. Keep the child calm and comfortable until medical	al
service arrives. Call the child's parents.

Assumption of the Risk and Waiver of Liability Relating to Coronavirus/COVID-19

The novel coronavirus, COVID-19, has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization. COVID-19 is extremely contagious and is believed to spread mainly from person-to-person contact. As a result, federal, state, and local governments and federal and state health agencies recommend social distancing and have, in many locations, prohibited the congregation of groups of people.

Fabricate Studios ("Fabricate") has put in place preventative measures to reduce the spread of COVID-19; however, Fabricate cannot guarantee that you or your child(ren) will not become infected with COVID-19.
